Crystal Plume Angers has been a member of the Medical Physics community for over 25 years working both in industry and in the hospital. From 1994 to 2006, Crystal worked as a Medical Physicist in industry and filled roles in product management, project leadership, process engineering and software development.

In 2006 Crystal transitioned from industry to the public sector and became a Medical Physicist at the Ottawa Hospital Cancer Centre. In 2008 she became a member of the Canadian College of Physicists in Medicine and was subsequently certified as a Fellow in 2015. While at the Ottawa Hospital, Crystal has focused her work in Quality and Safety and has made contributions in these areas locally, provincially and nationally.

Crystal served as Treasurer on the board of the Canadian Organization of Medical Physicists from 2012 to 2017. She is Co-Chair of the Cancer Care Ontario Radiation Incident and Safety Committee (CCO - RISC) and holds academic appointments with the Ottawa Hospital Research Institute and the University of Ottawa, Faculty of Medicine.
