



W. John Braun got his Ph.D. in Statistics from the University of Western Ontario in 1992. Since then, he has held positions at a number of universities, including Western for 14 years where he attained the rank of Full Professor and was Chair of the Statistics Graduate Program for 5 years. In 2014, he took the opportunity to become Head of Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics at UBC's Okanagan campus.

He is also Deputy Director of the Canadian Statistical Sciences Institute. Braun's research in statistics is motivated by scientific problems, coming from psychology, biology, medicine, engineering and physics. His methodological contributions are concerned with computational issues around uncertainty quantification and smoothing techniques. He has published over 60 peer-reviewed journal articles and two books in the area of computational statistics.
