**Biography**

Yani is currently TRIUMF Project Officer at the Accelerators and Class II Facilities Division (ACFD) of the CNSC. He first joined CNSC in 2008 as a licensing officer and inspector in ACFD, then moved to the CNSC laboratory in 2010 as a physics specialist and RSO for their Class II and consolidated licences before returning to ACFD in 2013.

Prior to joining CNSC, Yani worked in the Consumer and Clinical Radiation Protection Bureau of Health Canada as a medical physicist in the Medical X-ray and mammography Division from 1999 to 2008.

Yani was a graduate student at the Medical Radiation Physics Unit of McGill University from 1990 to 1997, where he obtained a MSc on Positron Emission Tomography (PET) Monte Carlo Simulations and worked on a PhD on PET Movement Correction. He also worked as a postdoctoral fellow at Université de Sherbrooke on PET iterative image reconstruction from 1997 to 1999.
