This temporary, full-time position (6 months) – based at Niagara Health’s St. Catharines Site – is an exciting opportunity for a Medical Physicist to provide expertise that contributes to radiation oncology imaging and treatment.

Reporting to the Manager of Medical Physics at the Walker Family Cancer Centre, you will provide scientific expertise to the Centre through the application of physics to medicine. Your primary focus as a Medical Physicist will be to assist in Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT) commissioning, including characterization of equipment used, but you will also be expected to advise Radiation Oncologists and Dosimetrists, as required.

To join our dynamic team as a Medical Physicist, you must be a collaborative, experienced scientist whose knowledge base and skill set include:

- PhD in Medical Physics or a related subject from a recognized university
- Demonstrated scientific problem-solving ability
- Successful completion of a CAMPEP-accredited residency in radiation oncology physics or equivalent
- Certification, or eligibility for certification, in radiation oncology physics by the Canadian College of Physicists in Medicine
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Strong organizational skills, including the ability to prioritize a workload.
